The Hometown Hero Banner Program honors the men and women who have served or are currently serving in the United States Military, and our first responders. This program offers the opportunity to recognize hometown heroes with a personalized banner displayed prominently on a light pole banner along the Baldwin Corridor.

Each banner will feature the hero's name, photo, years of service, and branch of service or department/agency served, serving as a visible tribute to their dedication, sacrifice, and commitment to our nation. Banners will be displayed from Memorial Day to Veteran's Day, the year the banner was purchased.

Banners cost \$100 each. Proceeds to benefit the Orion Veterans Memorial, located at the corner of Lapeer and Odanah Roads.

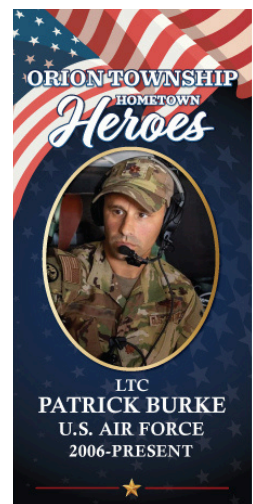
